I, John Ramsy, a loyal citizen, and a resident of _ County of Livingston State of Missouri hereby claim compensation, under the provisions of Section 24, Act approved February 24, 1864, and Section 2, Act approved July 28, 1866, for my Slave, Thomas Jasper enlisted 1863 at St. Joseph sent there by me & delivered to Recruiter officer who put him in the _ Regiment U.S. Colored Troops Co. certificate of which enlistment, and a descriptive list, as required, accompanying this application.

In proof of my loyalty to the Constitution and Government of the United States, I present the accompanying oath, which I have taken, signed and acknowledged; to be filed with this application, in accordance with requirement of General Order No. 329, 1863, War Department, Adjutant General's Office.
